Memorial gifts are traditionally given at the time of a person's passing. The invitation is often listed in the obituary as *in Lieu of flowers*. They are a means of saying that a person was important and will be missed. Memorials gifts may be given on the anniversary of someone's death, or on another date significant in the life of that individual. A gift in memory of a loved one can be fitting tribute, and can also benefit the mission of a favorite Catholic institution. Often, words seem an inadequate way to express our sympathy.

A Memorial Gift can be that unstated but deeply thoughtful expression of our feelings. Similarly, gifts are given to honor someone who is still alive. It is a celebration of one's life at an anniversary, birthday, or just to say thanks

There are many opportunities to remember or honor a loved one or an occasion by making a memorial gift to the parish. These may include creating an endowment to help needy families, a donation to St. Vincent de Paul Society, making a gift to benefit our youth program, or giving stocks or securities to help maintain and grow our parish funds for future generations.
